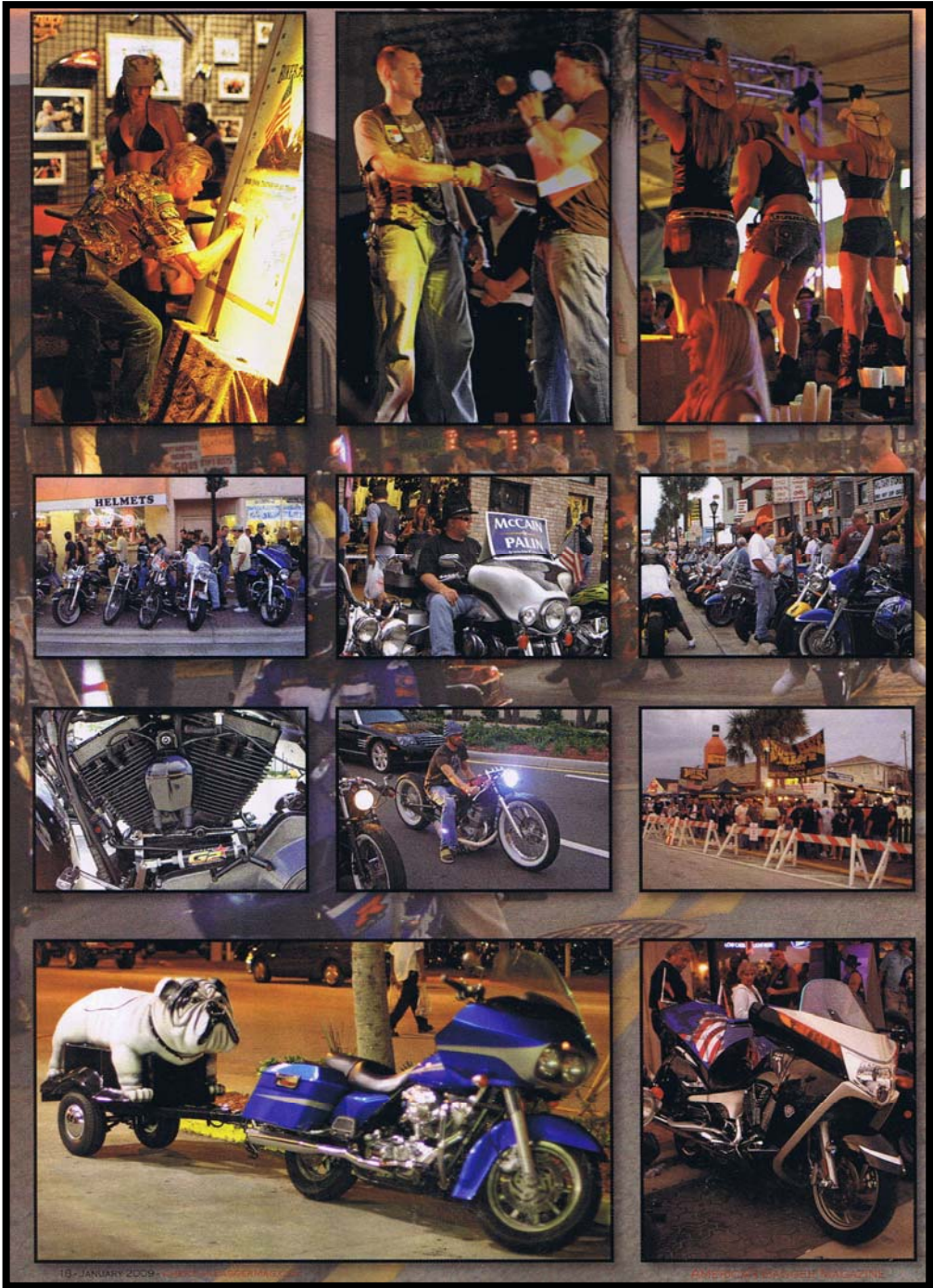


BIKETOBERFEST 2008, Fun in the Sun!
